

RESULTS OF THE BUSINESS MEETING
ON MAY 27TH, 2004, ISTANBUL – TURKEY

Following the opening address of ASAMI 2004, the following subjects have been voted among the participants:

1. Each National ASAMI President may vote. All motions will be based on the majority decision of one vote for each country represented. The honorary member from Kurgan will represent Russia without the right to vote (yes: 13, no: 1, President Catagni and Honorary Member have not voted.).

2. The IA will meet at least once every two years (every year:2, .every 2 years: 13, every 3 years:1).

3. The location of the next meeting in 2006 has been voted (Brasil: 2 Japan: 12, India: 1).

The decision: the meeting in 2006 will be held in Japan.

4. The location of the meeting in 2008 has been voted (Egypt: 3, Russia: 7, Portugal: 5).

The decision: the meeting in 2008 will be held in Russia. If Russia reports within one year to have technical inconveniences organizing the meeting, it will be held in Portugal.

5. The International ASAMI Meeting will take place every two years. The venue will be decided by a majority vote of the Executive Committee. The meeting venue will alternate between Europe (including the Middle East and Mediterranean countries and Russia) and the rest of the world. The meeting venue will be decided four years in advance. If a country selected needs to withdraw from hosting a meeting the meeting will automatically be awarded to the runner up venue of the vote.

6. The election for the next IA president and vice president resulted: T. Matsushita (Japan): 10, J. Birch (USA): 5. T. Matsushita has been elected to be the president and J. Birch the vice president.

7. The official web page of the IA will be updated by the elected president.
